



International Instructors working in the US

- The U.S. ski industry—working with PSIA/AASI and with the National Ski Areas Association—is currently applying for a special use visa with the U.S. State Department that would enable highly certified foreign ski/snowboard instructors to obtain a work-authorization visa to work in the U.S.
- If approved, international instructors could legally work in the U.S. under the J-1 Visa program at US ski areas
- It would apply for instructors from the Southern Hemisphere, Europe and Asia ski areas

Golden Peak Base Area Capacity



VAIL NORDIC CENTER: 7 MINUTES FROM GOLDEN PEAK








Access for On-Snow Workshops & Demo Slope

- Cross-country ski track and Terrain Park available and accessible




Travel for Interski 2027: Denver International Airport








Denver International Airport 2 hours OR Eagle County Regional Airport 35 minutes





Congress Details:

Town of Vail, Meeting space, Hotels/Condominiums and Pricing

Hotel / Condominium Deposit Dates and Requirements

Below is the Average Deposit Policy – individual properties may differ

- April 20, 2025 Non-refundable, 10% advance payment required in order to guarantee hotel/condominium location per country
- April 1, 2026 Non-refundable, additional 10% deposit required
- February 1, 2027 Final remaining payment in full required



Interski Requirements for Complimentary Congress Packages:

- Congress package price with average lodging costs based on the entire national delegation for half of demonstrators (maximum 5) of that nation.
- Congress package price with average lodging costs based on the entire national delegation for one additional participant for every fifteenth paying participant per nation i.e. the 16th participant gets a free congress package.
- General Assembly for all international organizations in April 2025 is available at the Hythe Hotel
- Availability for Interski Pillar Associations (IVSI, ISIA, IAESS) to add extra days to Congress
- Availability for Teams to train early with advance notice
