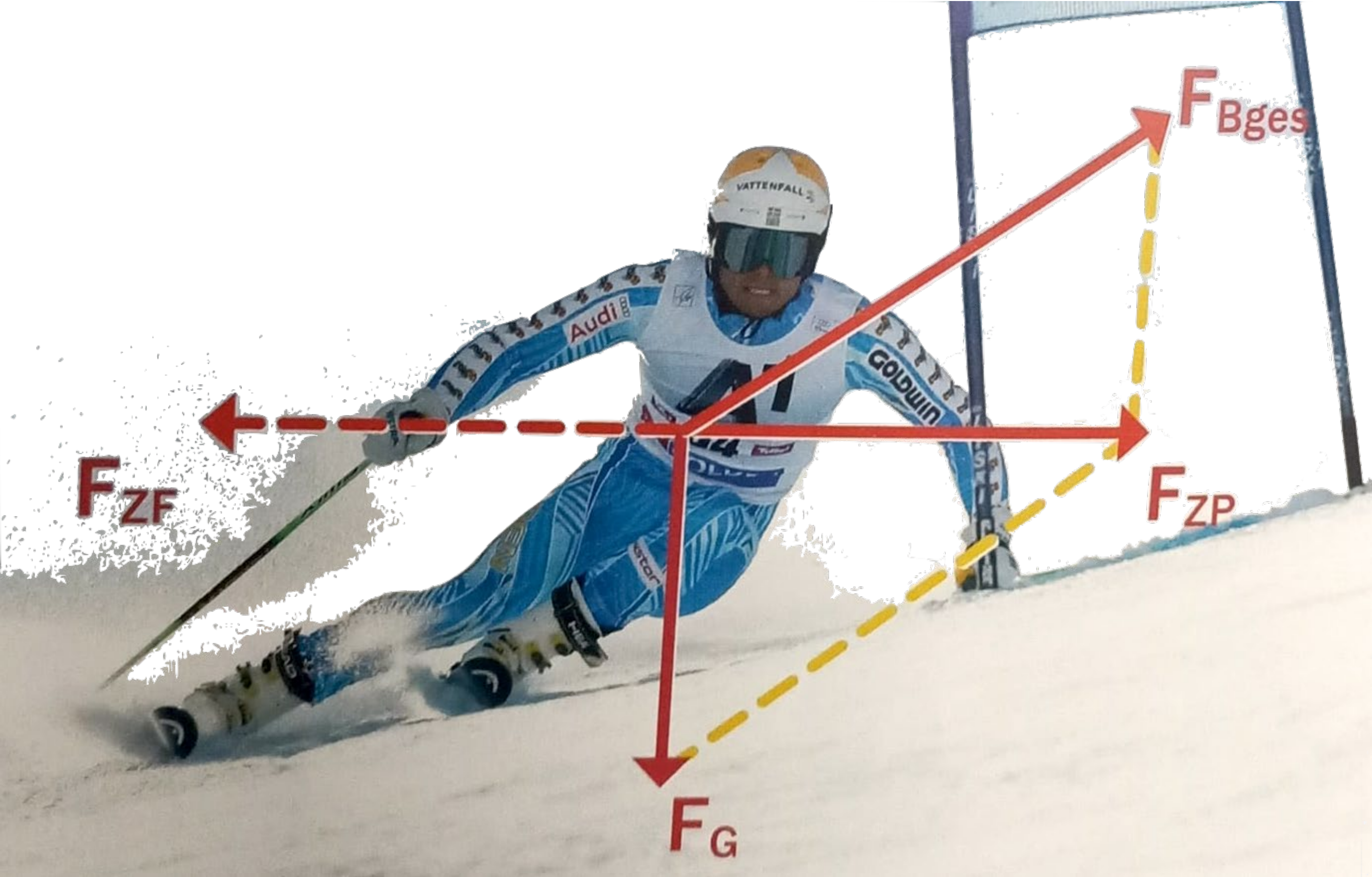
# The Alpine Basic Position

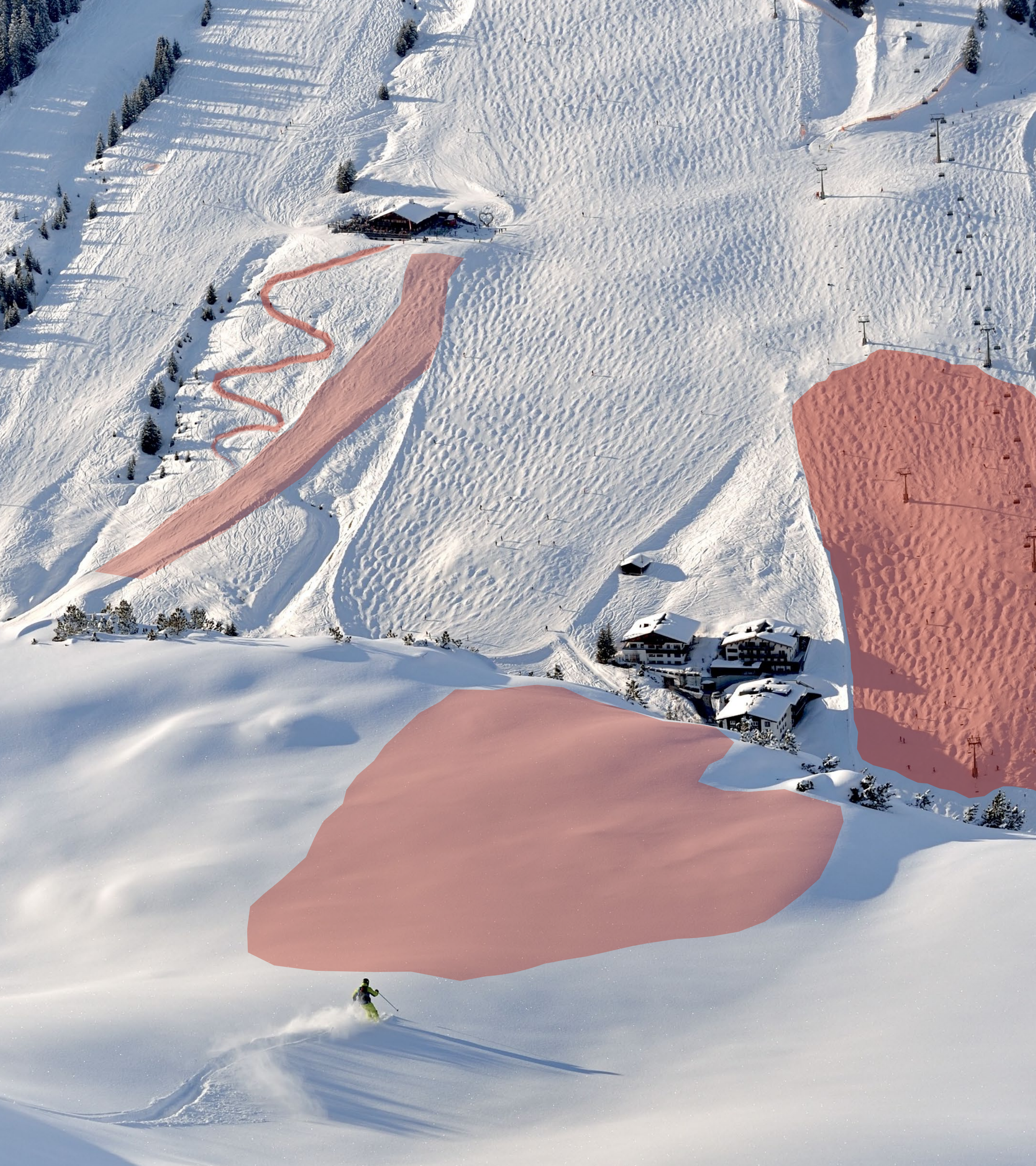
